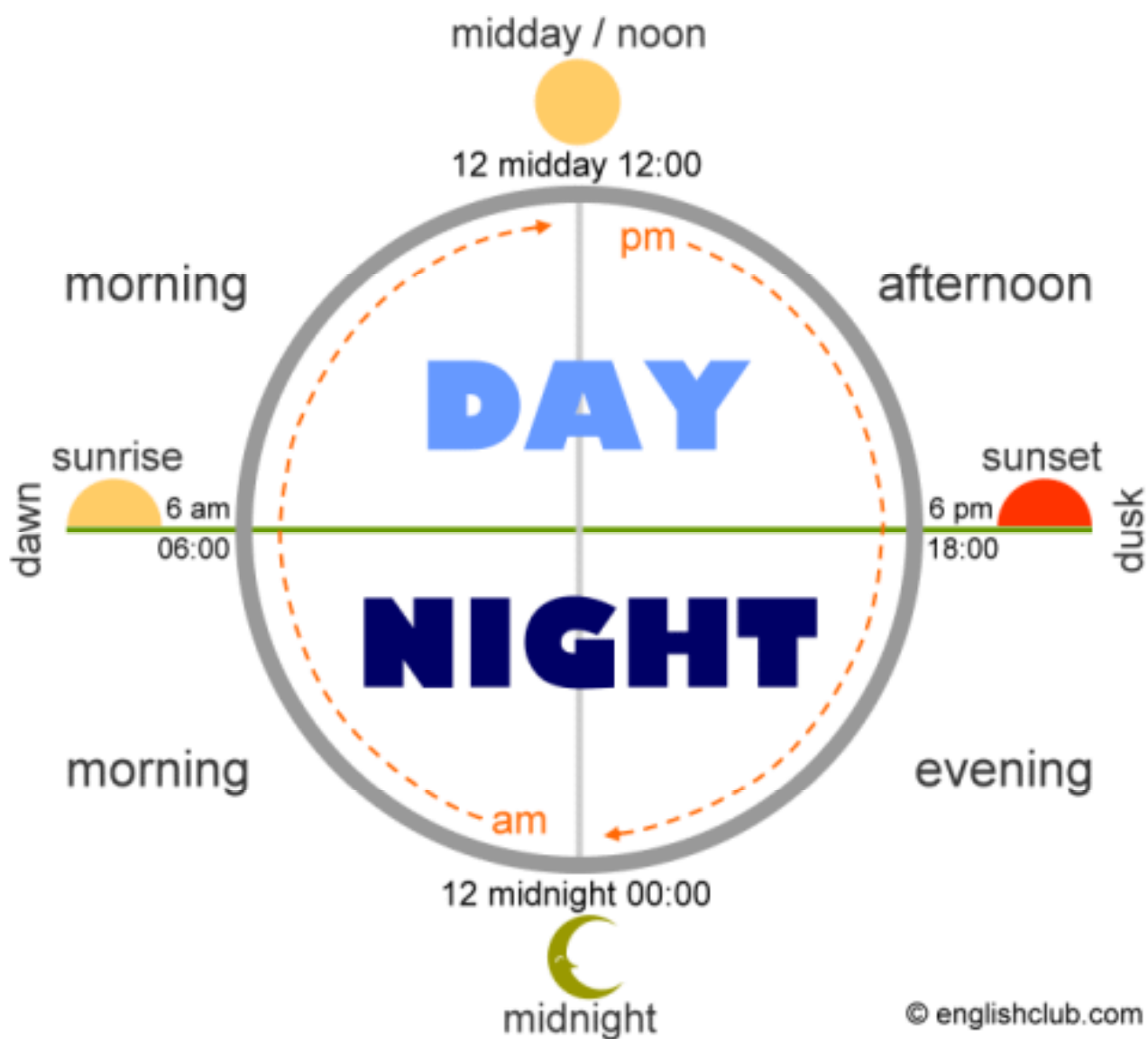


Some Prepositions of Time
